

TWO-WAY COLUMBIA STREET TRANSIT IMPROVEMENTS

Columbia Street (between 1st Avenue and 3rd Avenue)

The Seattle Department of Transportation is working with King County Metro to implement changes to Columbia Street between 1st Avenue and 3rd Avenue to provide more reliable all-day transit service between West Seattle and Downtown. These improvements are scheduled to be complete by early December 2019.

SDOT is planning the following changes:

Between 1st Ave and 2nd Ave

- The southern curb lane will be changed to a 24-hour bus-only lane to allow buses to travel eastbound on Columbia St.
- The existing left turn only lane will be

converted to a left turn plus through lane.

- A new bus signal will be installed at Columbia St and 2nd Ave to manage the new eastbound bus traffic.

Between 2nd Ave and 3rd Ave

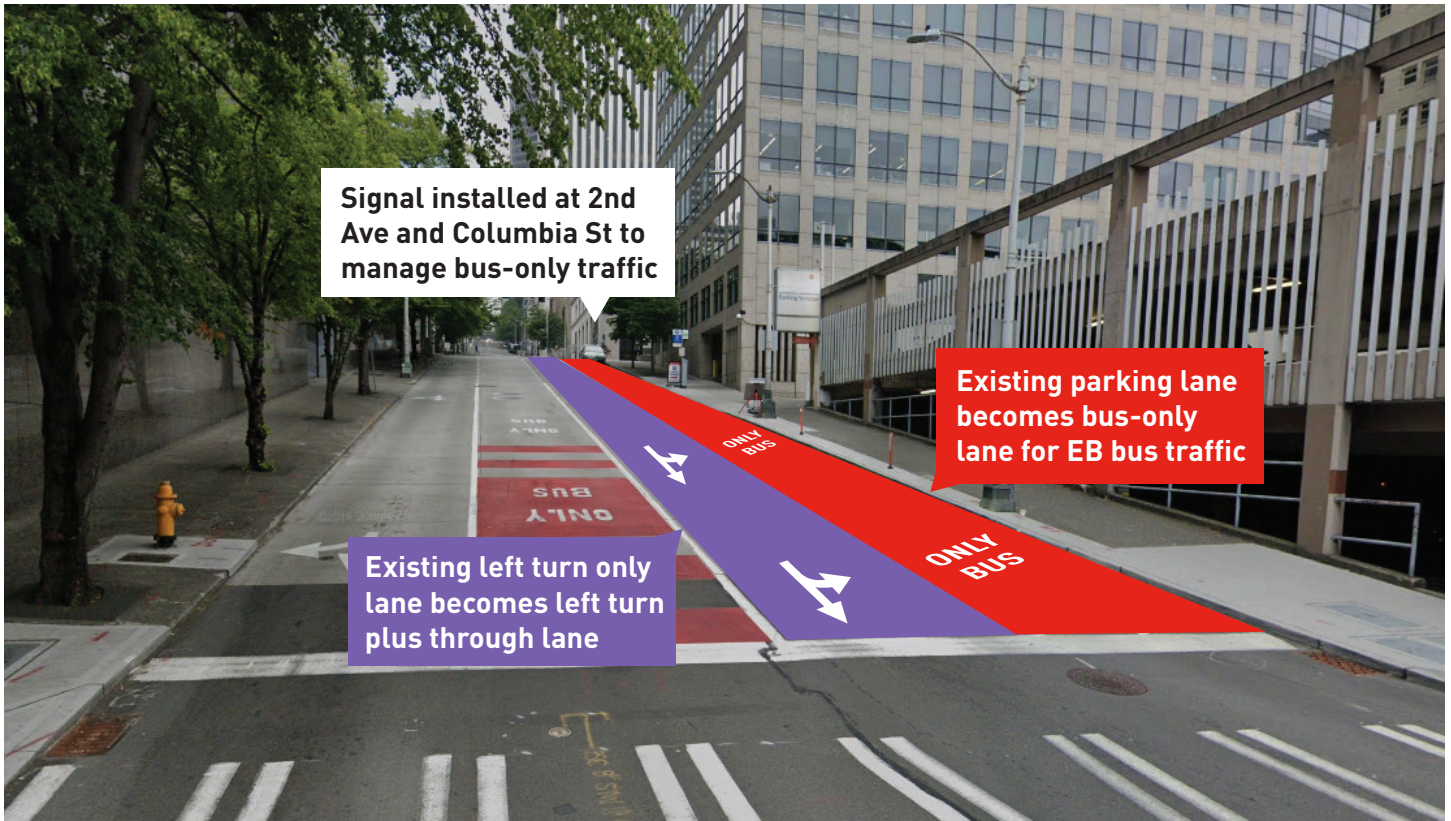
- The southern curb lane will be changed to a 24-hour bus-only lane to allow eastbound buses on Columbia St to turn left onto 3rd Ave.
- The existing through lane adjacent to the new contra-flow lane will be converted to a left turn plus through lane.
- A new bus signal will be installed at Columbia St and 3rd Ave to manage the new left turning bus traffic.
